Letter from the President

NBHRMS Members,

I am honored and humbled to serve you and the NB Railroad Museum as the President for 2025. We truly have a busy, fun year ahead! This being January, I'd like to take a moment to look back on the previous year and to take stock of our achievements.

In 2024, NBHRMS members once again hosted two successful Jamboree Train Shows in October and April, and traveled to the New Braunfels Library, the Mamman Family Public Library in Bulverde, and Hobby Lobby in San Antonio for T-Trak model shows. Members brought their most prized railroad or model railroad items to a Show and Tell in July. We also hosted open houses for the New Braunfels Spooktacular and Wassailfest events, partnered with the Brauntex for pictures with Santa in front of Lucky #7 before their showing of the Polar Express, and hosted a reception in April for the dedication of the Historic Outdoor Art Museum (HOAM) railroad-themed mural across the street from the Museum.

Our major facility project for 2024 was the renovation of the artifact storage room to add insulation and climate control and double the shelving. This space allows us to consolidate, preserve and protect all our artifacts and archival documents in one location.

We also welcomed new Station Agents and welcomed back Susan Riordan after an extended absence. Susan is our new Station Manager and will be helping the Board of Directors implement new business practices in the next year. For example, we instituted electronic scheduling and time-clocking for employees and documented employee policies at the end of the year.

Beginning in January 2024, the Museum started taking credit and debit cards for gift shop sales and in-person monetary donations. This was a big step for the Museum, and it has, literally, paid off! Compared to 2023, gift shop sales doubled this year and donations rose by over 70%. Dining *Continued on page 2*

What Is That Thing?

Answer: Caboose Marker Lights indicated the end of the train at night to protect the train from being rear-ended. The lamps would normally show the red facing to the rear when the caboose was on a main line. Green would be shown to the side and front, although the Santa Fe and some other railroads called for yellow to the side and front. Green faced the rear when the caboose was on a passing siding clear of the main line. When stopped on a double track or running the against the current of traffic on a double track, the inside rear marker would be green, while the outside would be red.
